

CVRC Club June Board Meeting Minutes
June 20, 2010

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 am by President Dan Metz. Also present were Craig Waters, Dick Knapp and Chris Ritter. Both Murray Ross and Joe Scuro had provided their input prior to the meeting.

Dan stated that since our last meeting before the summer break was next Tuesday, June 29th, we needed to decide what action the club should take on hosting the 2011 Scale Masters National Championships. After some discussion, we decided that the challenge would be good for the club and would establish our club as a leader.

Dan said that the event was tentatively planned for one of the last two weeks in October. This year's event will be held Sept. 16-19, 2010 and will be hosted by the Ohio River View RC Modelers (<http://orvrcef.com/>). A really bare bones field compared with ours!

At the 2009 Scale Masters, they had 47 aircraft entered and about 150 people attended the banquet on Saturday evening. You can go to (<http://usscalemasters.org/>) for more information. You can also go to RC Groups and check for Scalemasters info.

We have been requested to line up a hotel with 50 rooms set aside for less than \$100 per night. They will also need banquet facilities for about 150 people. They would also like a hospitality room for Thursday - Saturday evenings. They also want extra security in the parking lot for Thursday - Saturday nights. Dick Knapp agreed to work the hotel issue.

Dan agreed to check out the past history of this event, now in its 31st year. Murray Ross will be tasked with identifying / training the judges for this event.

It was also agreed that we would prepare a special rack card advertising this event at our field. We will also establish newspaper and TV coverage contacts this fall. In the discussion that followed, we felt that we might want to have a booth at next year's AMA show to spread the word and increase the public attendance. We will probably drop down to a single booth at the Jacqueline Cochran Air Show in Sept, but put more focus on this event.

This will be a great time for our scale modelers to get out to some of our local events in the coming year and place in the top 30 % which qualifies them for the Nationals.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:45 am.
